### **Impact of School PE Funding 2018/2019**

With this funding we have aimed to improve the provision of PE and sport in our school. Children have begun to participate in both competitive and friendly matches with other junior and primary schools in the local area.

At Kinson Academy we have always promoted the importance of sport in our school. We believe that sport enhances the lives of our children by teaching them to be active and healthy and live a healthy lifestyle. Sport also teaches children morals when following rules and developing sportsmanship. The social aspect of school and learning is also met through sport in team games. Sporting excellence and participation has always been a very strong focus in our school.

We ensured that the school has a variety of equipment to teach a range of skills and sports.

Below is a summary of how we have spent the Sport Premium Funds and how the Sports Premium is having an impact on the quality, participation, skill development and enjoyment of PE at Kinson Academy.

Sports Provision from outside providers in the following areas:

- Multi-sports KS1 linked to numeracy – AFCB
- Upper Key stage 2 skills – Yr 6 PE curriculum – offered CPD for Yr 6 staff
- Lunchtime football club for Yrs 4-6

We ensured that the school has a variety of equipment to teach a range of skills and sports. Below is a list of equipment that has been purchased in order to deliver PE lessons effectively and for the children to experience new sports:

- Medals for every child on sports day and End of Year trophies
- Multi-sports day for key stage 1 and 2
- PPG funding for clubs
- Ball skills equipment

### **Impact of Funding:**

Within the playtime provision, pupils have been playing small-sided games and learning how to win and lose appropriately. Children have also participated in both competitive and friendly matches with other junior and primary schools in the local area. This academic year, funding has supported Kinson's enrichment coordinator to spend time training in our schools as well as experienced Enrichment coordinators offering CPD at school. Playtime provision has improved with zoned areas which include, ICT, drawing and creative room, team games, and board games.

Kinson Academy is proud to offer our children a range of extra-curricular activities which are led by our Curriculum Enrichment Leader. Currently the extra-curricular clubs on offer to all pupils, free of charge, are: Netball, Football, Change for Life, Striking & Fielding, Multi-Skills, Invasion Games, yoga.

Club data from 2018-19 shows the increased number of sporting opportunities available for the pupils at Kinson.

Autumn term 2018/2019 - 3 Clubs (Netball, Football & Change for Life) 90 spaces, 85 taken (All KS2)

Spring term 2018/2019 - 3 Clubs (Netball, Football & Change for Life) 90 spaces, 80 taken (All KS2)

Summer term 2018/2019 - 7 Clubs (Netball [30], KS1- Multi-Skills [25], Football [20], AFCB Football [20], Yoga [20], Y2-6 - Striking & Fielding [24] & AFCB Active Numeracy [16]) 165 places, 164 taken
