

Our topic for the next half term in Year 5 is:

Maths

This half term, we will be building on our knowledge of fractions. We will be learning how to multiply fractions, problem solving using fractions and calculating fractions of amounts

After this, we will be looking at decimals and percentages, writing decimals as fractions and ordering, comparing and rounding decimals. We will also be looking at equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages.

We will also continue to focus on our multiplication facts and mental maths skills.

Topic

Our topic this half term is a history topic all about the Tudors.

'Off With Her Head. will teach children about an aspect of British history that extends pupil's chronological knowledge beyond 1066.

This will involve looking at aspects of Tudor life, the artist Hans Holbein linked to aspects of Tudor music and dance.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be exploring and discussing the topic 'Healthy Me.' This will include how to maintain a healthy lifestyle, make healthy lifestyle choices, how the media portray celebrities and how to maintain a healthy relationship with food.

English

Our class text this term is 'Journey to the River sea' by Eva Ibbotson. Will be using this and other linked texts in our comprehension lessons, to help further develop and embed our VIPER skills. (Vocabulary, Inference, Predicting, Explaining and Retrieval.)

During our English lessons, we will be writing a range of text types including, poetry using similes and metaphors, biographies, persuasive writing and instructions linked to revolting recipes. These will be linked to our class reader 'Journey to the River Sea', and Terrible Tudors (Horrible Histories.)

We will continue to develop our editing skills by evaluating and improving our own writing and the writing of our peers.

Enrichment

We will be starting this topic by exploring the Tudor timeline, Tudor music and instruments. We will research King Henry VIII and aspects of Tudor life. We will look at the art of Hans Holbein and Tudor explorers.
